16-Sep-25	Shanghai, Jiangnan water town, silk factory visit, Yu Garden, Shanghai Tower Zhujiajiao, Yu Garden, Shanghai Tower & The Bund	
	This morning, visit Zhujiajiao, a picturesque water town with ancient stone bridges, Ming and Qing architecture, and peaceful canals. Enjoy a boat ride along the river and explore local shops and delicacies.	
	Next, visit a silk factory before heading to Yu Garden, a serene classical garden with pavilions, rockeries, and ponds. Stroll through the garden and nearby bazaar for souvenirs.	
	Then, visit the Town God's Temple, dedicated to the protector deity of the town.	
	Explore the Shanghai Tower, one of the tallest buildings in the world, offering panoramic city views.  Afterward, walk down Nanjing Road, Shanghai's bustling shopping street, and enjoy the contrast of old and new at the Bund, Shanghai's iconic waterfront promenade.	
17-Sep-25	Xian, Xian Tour	
	Explore Xi'an: Ancient City Wall, Muslim Quarter, and Iconic Towers	
	Upon arrival in Xi´an, begin your tour at the Ancient City Wall, the best-preserved city wall in China and a national treasure. Walk along its storied ramparts for a bird´s-eye view of the inner and outer city, or opt for a bike ride along the wall (at your own expense) for a unique perspective.	
	After descending from the wall, visit the vibrant Muslim Quarter, home to the Hui people. This bustling area offers a variety of authentic Muslim cuisine, local snacks, and souvenirs. It's the perfect spot to savor Xi'an's flavors or pick up a memorable gift.	
	Conclude your day with an outside view of the Bell Tower and Drum Tower, two iconic landmarks steeped in history. Built during the Ming Dynasty, the Bell Tower once announced time and significant events. While climbing the towers is not included, their striking architecture and cultural significance make them must-see attractions. (Note: Towers close at 5:00 PM.)

16-3ep-25	Discover the Terracotta Warriors and Journey to Shanghai	
	Discover the refractita vvariors and journey to Shanghai	
	Begin your day with a visit to the awe-inspiring Terracotta Warriors and Horses Museum, one of the most significant archaeological discoveries of the 20th century. This vast site showcases the life-size terracotta army of Qin Shi Huang, China's first emperor. Marvel at the intricate details of the soldiers, horses, chariots, and weapons, each uniquely crafted to guard the emperor in the afterlife. Explore the history and culture of the Qin dynasty and gain a deeper appreciation for the enduring legacy of this UNESCO World Heritage Site.	
	Before departing Xi´an, stop at a jade carving store, where you can learn about this cherished Chinese art form and its cultural significance.	
	Finally, board your flight to Shanghai. Upon arrival, you'll be warmly greeted and transferred to your	
	hotel, ready to explore the vibrant city ahead.	
18-Sep-25	Xi'an - Beijing , High-speed train	
19-Sep-25	Beijing, Forbidden City & Tiananmen Square	
	In the morning, walk in the footsteps of emperors in the Forbidden City and wander through	
	Tiananmen Square, the world's largest public plaza. Tiananmen Square Prepare to be overwhelmed by	
	the sheer size of one of the world's largest public squares, measuring in at 440,000 square meters	
	(over 109 acres). As you walk from the southernmost part of the square all the way down its length,	
	you will pass several monuments, including the mausoleum that houses Chairman Mao's remains (exterior).	
	The northern gate of the square features a portrait of the PRC's founding father and is also the gate through which you will enter the Forbidden City.	
	Enter the Forbidden City and walk in the steps of emperors The Forbidden City was completed in	
	1420, and was home to 24 emperors, the last of which left Beijing in 1924. The entire imperial	
	complex is reputed to have 9999 rooms, which at its peak housed up to 10,000 people, including the imperial family, 3000 eunuchs, as well as maids and concubines.	
	Discover for yourself why the 170 acres were forbidden to common people as you stroll through what	
	is arguably the best-preserved example of classical Chinese architecture in the world.	
	Enjoy a tea ceremony at a tea store.	
	Start a tour to Hutong in the afternoon. Rickshaw Ride & Hutong Tour The word "hutong" refers to the	
	narrow network of lanes created by closely built quadrangular homes. Once the primary architectural	
	feature of China's capital city, hutongs now make up only a small fraction of Beijing, having been	
	replaced by high-rise buildings in recent years. Recapture the feeling of Beijing's past from the	
	wooden seat of a traditional rickshaw and visit a local family's courtyard home along the way	



20-Sep-25	Beijing, Temple of Heaven & The Great Wall of China
	Morning Excursion: Temple of Heaven & Great Wall of China
	Begin your day with a visit to the Temple of Heaven, a sacred site where ancient emperors prayed for bountiful harvests. Today, the surrounding area is a lively park where locals gather for morning exercises. Watch as they practice Tai Chi, fan dancing, or shuttlecock kicking, offering a glimpse into daily Chinese culture.
	Next, journey to the Great Wall of China at the Mutianyu section, renowned for its tranquility and stunning views. This iconic structure, the longest man-made construction in history, spans an incredible 50,000 kilometers of interconnected defense walls built over 2,000 years. At Mutianyu, a 2.5-kilometer stretch with 22 watchtowers invites you to explore its storied history.
	Enjoy a cable car ride to the top (included in the tour), offering breathtaking aerial views of this engineering marvel. Walk along the ancient path for over an hour, immersing yourself in the grandeur of one of the world's most awe-inspiring wonders.
	Return to your hotel in the afternoon, with the evening free for leisure and exploration at your own pace.
